**Stephen E. Gierhart**, 66, of Cambridge, passed away peacefully at his home on Friday (March 13, 2015). He was born September 18, 1948 in Logan, son of the late Neal F. Gierhart and Dorothy (Vollmer) Gierhart. Steve was a 1966 graduate of Logan High School and a 1970 graduate of Ohio University of Athens.
